We are wanting to find brave, passionate performers who are excited to take on a dystopian, political, feminist world premiere. We are very excited to assemble a strong ensemble of artists to share this important story.

OHIO! Audition: Open Casting

We are committed to inclusive casting where all applicants are valued for their own identity. We prioritise building a safe audition environment and strive to cast a team that accurately reflects the society and community we live in today. As such, we seek performers from all backgrounds, races, and ethnicities. We strongly encourage submissions from Indigenous, Bla(c)k, People of Colour (BIPOC), Neurodivergent, LGBTQIA+, Disabled performers, and Gender Diverse Performers.

We are happy to answer any questions or provide further details regarding the gender identities and sexual orientation of the characters as written. Actors are welcome to apply for any role they feel comfortable playing regardless of their personal gender identity and sexual orientation. Please note, all of the characters are female-identifying.

We have no specific costume requirements or aesthetic visions that call for actors of a specific body type, and we encourage artists of all sizes to apply. We are committed to ensuring you are physically and emotionally comfortable and we will actively interrogate bias.

We also endeavor to remain honest and transparent about casting requirements and pre-production choices. The characters also have age ranges specific and relevant to the story and themes of the play. As such, we are aiming to cast actors within the playing ages noted for each character.

If you have any specific questions regarding our capacity to support you as a performer, please do not hesitate to get in touch. Part of our commitment to building a safe environment within a small company involves being transparent about the resources we have available.

We want our production to be a warm, welcoming and enjoyable experience that our performers look back on positively. We want to do everything possible to reduce the risk of harm, and we believe honest communication is key. If applicants have specific accessibility requirements or require resources that we are unable to provide, we will be clear and honest with them and we encourage applicants to communicate their needs if they feel comfortable doing so.

The Characters

This is an ensemble piece, with all of the characters' objectives and storylines intertwined within a collective narrative. We are looking for a group/family/unit of cooperative artists to bring this story to life.

Please note that the first round of auditions will be a general audition, NOT be for a specific character.

You need not be, but all characters are:

- Female presenting,
- · Any ethnicity,
- 25-35 years old.

The characters below make up the punk-sketch group called the Uteri. They met and formed the group in college.

Gabby: Calm, authoritative, magnetic, Leo.

Kimmie: Prickly, aggressive, sarcastic, Aries.

Lettie: Cheerful, eccentric, sincere, Pisces.

Molly: Elegant, aloof, taciturn, Libra

Sunny: Fervent, anxious, pedantic, Virgo

The interrogator is the cop who arrests and interrogates the women after they crash the Broadway musical, OHIO! They also play a silent role in Act 2, the Red Cross Witness. (Interrogator and Red Cross Witness are played by the same actor.)

Interrogator: Direct, warm, patient, Gemini.

Red Cross Witness: Silent, sober, compassionate, Cancer.

The Audition Process

First Round: Self-tape.

We ask you to:

• Prepare a slate with your name, pronouns, age and a fun fact about yourself.

Prepare both:

- A contemporary (TV, film, theatre) monologue. Max. 2 minutes
- A contemporary (TV, film, theatre) scene. Max. 2 minutes

Please include a General American accent for both pieces.

You may pick whatever pieces you like, but we strongly encourage things in the style of the show; punk, rebel, feminist, bold. (e.g., The Handmaid's Tale, V for Vendetta, George Orwell, Franz Kafka.)

Second Round: Workshop

Some actors will then be invited to an in-person audition workshop. This will involve brief scene work, cold reading, and a quick chat.

Final Round: Chemistry

Some actors may then be invited to come to another in-person chemistry audition. This will involve further cold reading from script excerpts and group work.
